## OVER 600 REPUBLICANS ENDORSE DENNIS MOORE FOR CONGRESS

(LENEXA, KS) – Congressman Dennis Moore's bipartisan record in Congress today led to more than 600 Republicans endorsing Moore for re-election in Kansas' Third Congressional District. This is almost 200 more than joined the "Republicans for Moore" committee in 1998.

"Dennis Moore is an independent voice for all of us. He has done an excellent job in Congress and he deserves to be re-elected," said Ellen Laner, one of the four co-chairs of the Republicans for Moore Committee. The other three are Walt Hiersteiner, William C. Nelson, and Wynn Presson.

"Dennis Moore gives moderate Republicans an excellent choice in this election. His values and positions are very consistent with ours," said Presson. "He doesn't support Democratic ideas or Republican ideas, he supports good ideas," he said.

Moore's moderation is in contrast with the views of Republican challenger Phill Kline.

"Phill Kline has proven he is unpredictable and out of the mainstream of the Republican Party through his repeated confrontations with his colleagues in the Legislature. He shouldn't be our congressman and represent all of us in Congress," said Hiersteiner. Hiersteiner was chairperson of Senator Audrey Langworthy's campaign steering committee for several elections.

Congressman Moore said he appreciated the strong support of the

Republicans for Moore Committee in the 2000 election.

"I have represented the views and values of the people of the Third District, regardless of political party. Nowhere is this more evident than in the hundreds of real people who are supporting my campaign. I am pleased to have the support of the Republicans for Moore, as they will be a key part of our victory on November 7<sup>th</sup>," said Moore.
